

Fire and Auto Enterprises:

On April 12, 2006, John Kent, owner of Fire and Auto Enterprises, pled guilty to two charges under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993* and regulations relating to lifting and handling loads and lack of supervision and training. Mr. Kent was fined \$2,500 per count plus a victim fine surcharge of \$750 per count for a total fine of \$6,500. The company was charged following a February 22, 2005 incident in which a female worker sustained serious injury to her leg and ankle while assisting in the removal of a tractor tire.
